Title: Feeds in Small-Scale Aquaculture

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Abstract: Carp and tilapia are dominant species in freshwater fish culture in many Asian countries. Ma-

jority of carps and tilapias are produced by utilizing natural foods resulting from proper pond fertilization, often supplemented by artificial feeds to enhance fish yield and raise fish to a larger size than is possible with natural foods. Artificial feeds range from farm products such as grass and rice bran to farm-made, formulated feeds and commercial feeds. The choice of artificial

feeds depends mainly on the cost and availability of resources to small-scale farmers.

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
