Country Visited: Tajikistan

**Dates of Travel:** 6-11 June 2011

**Purpose of Trip:** attend the Central Asia regional meeting, participate in the "Pest Problems and Diagnostic Techniques" Workshop, and visit the IPM CRSP Research and Demonstration sites (Wheat, Tomato and Potato).

# Suggestions, Recommendations, and/or Follow-up Items:

Based on discussions at the meeting with IPM CRSP team members and diagnostic workshop participants, it was concluded that research on IPM of wheat, tomato and potato should be related to diagnosis and management of virus diseases in the Central Asia Region (Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan). The direction of CA IPM project should be made to creation of IPM packages on wheat, tomato, and potato through enhancement of training/education and outreach programs.

Rayapati should visit all three host countries and conduct needs-assessment for research and capacity building for virus research.

The Dean of Tajik National University expressed a strong need for supporting virology teaching for undergraduate students. Rayapati should consider giving more lectures to these students during his future visits to Tajikistan.
