Purpose of Trip: Attend a Planning and training workshop on abating the damage from the weed *Parthenium* in eastern Africa

Sites Visited: Addis Ababa, Ambo

Description of Activities/Observations:

Attended a training and planning workshop in Ambo. At the workshop several presentations were given ranging from gender equality, to rearing biocontrol agents, and to the status of *Parthenium* in various eastern African countries. I myself gave a presentation on status of *Parthenium* and other invasive alien species in Tanzania. The workshop was very interactive with many debates and discussing on how each objective of the 'Abating the damage from the weed *Parthenium*' Project would be achieved. The last afternoon included a site visit to a biocontrol facility. Here the whole group was shown the quarantine facilities in which *Zygograma* and *Listronotus* are being tested. We were also shown the nursery were *Parthenium* is be grown (from specimens harvested in the field) to supply the quarantine facility with the necessary testing plants. Challenges and successes of implementing and managing the facility were discussed.
