


# Feed the Future Innovation Labs for Collaborative Research Country Profile Liberia



### Long-term Degree Training

The Feed the Future Innovation Labs for Collaborative Research and the former Collaborative Research Support Programs (CRSPs) since 1978 have trained a total of 3 long-term degree students from Liberia earning 3 Masters degrees. Women received 33% of those degrees. Two degrees were granted by Makerere University and one by the University of Hawaii under BASIS AMA and Trop Soils.
