- Plan, direct, contribute to and monitor the quality of research, positioning CATIE strongly in the Central American agricultural sector.
- Participate, support and contribute to postgraduate education and training activities; ensure that program members contribute to courses and serve as supervisors for the development of the technical and leadership skills of students, practitioners and groups of producers.
- Supervise the program's quality and support technical assistance actions in various countries, in collaboration with projects and the Outreach and Development Division.
- Participate in the implementation of CATIE's strategic planning process; coordinate planning, monitoring and evaluation actions and elaborate program reports.
- Elaborate, edit and guide program members in the production of scientific and technical documents to be published in international, regional and national media sources.
- Give presentations at international and national scientific forums.
- Represent CATIE, strengthening its contact list and enhancing its work with international organizations, governments, NGOs and international cooperation agencies.
- Participate in meetings with donors, the board of directors and government ministries; interact with partners and participate in other national and international events.
- Lead and participate in the negotiation of proposals and strategic partnerships that help strengthen CATIE's work.
- Ensure the efficient and transparent use of financial, human and logistic resources of the core budget and projects assigned to the program.
