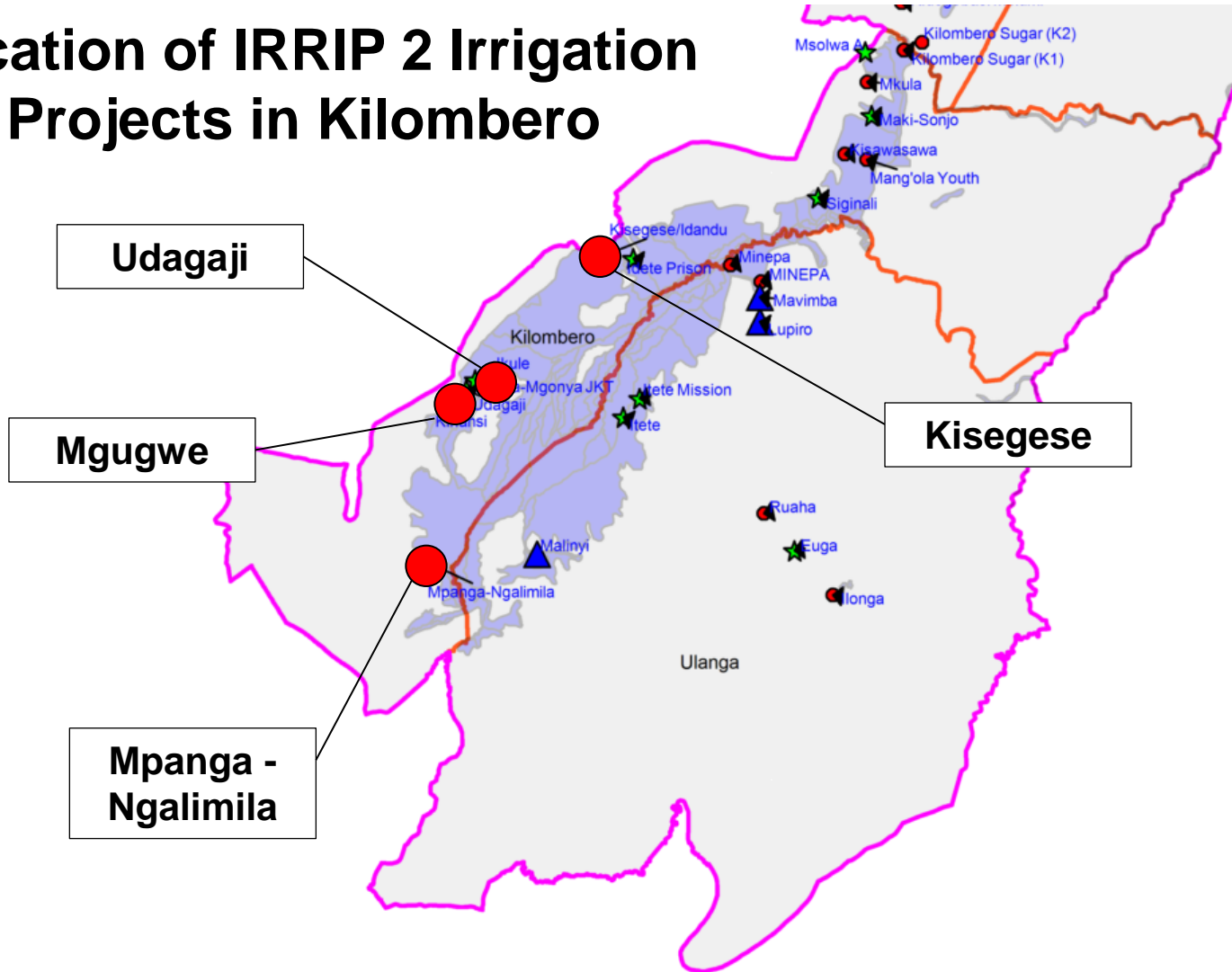

Southern Agriculture Growth Corridor Of Tanzania



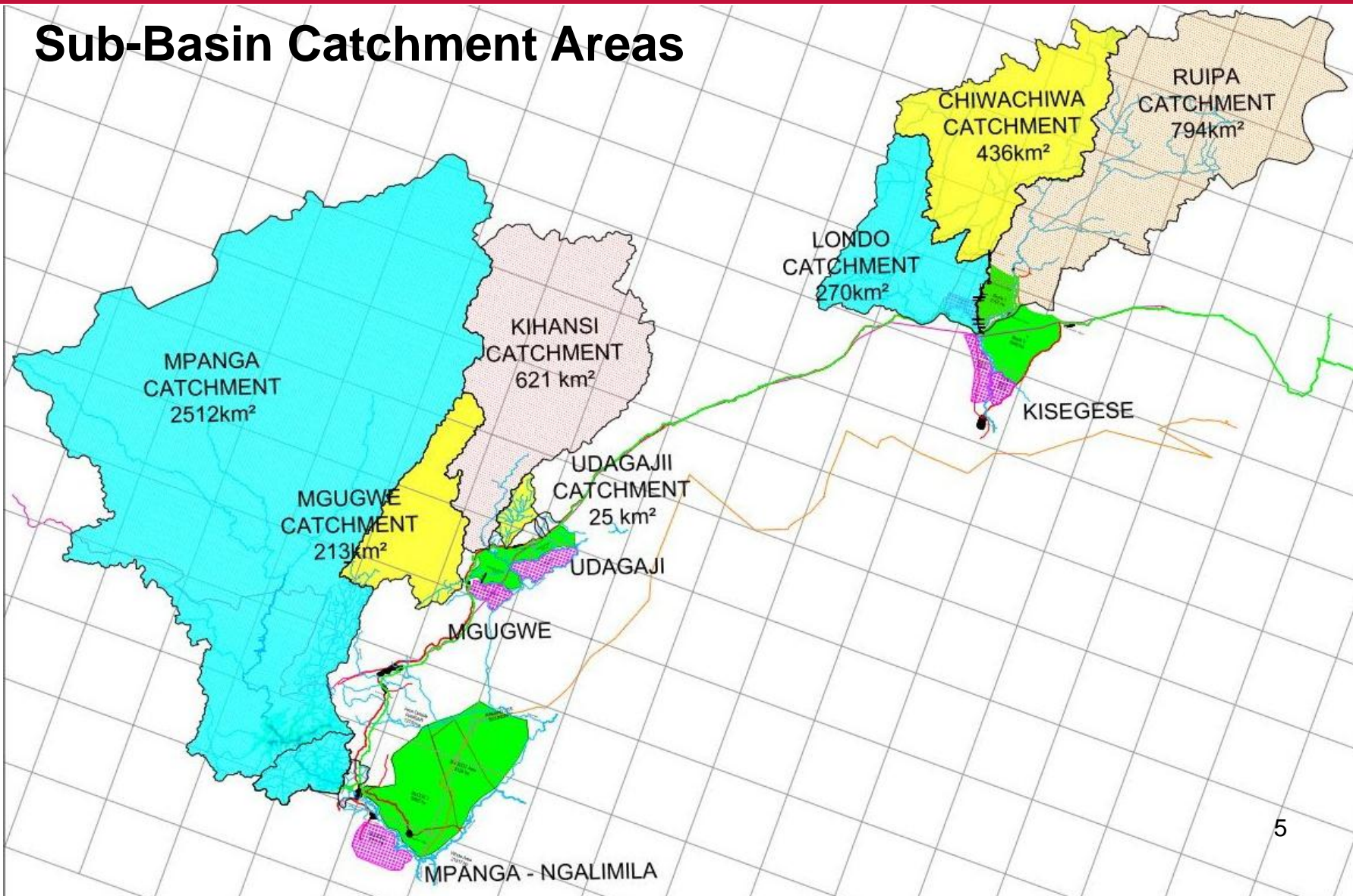


Location of IRRIP 2 Irrigation Projects in Kilombero





Sub-Basin Catchment Areas





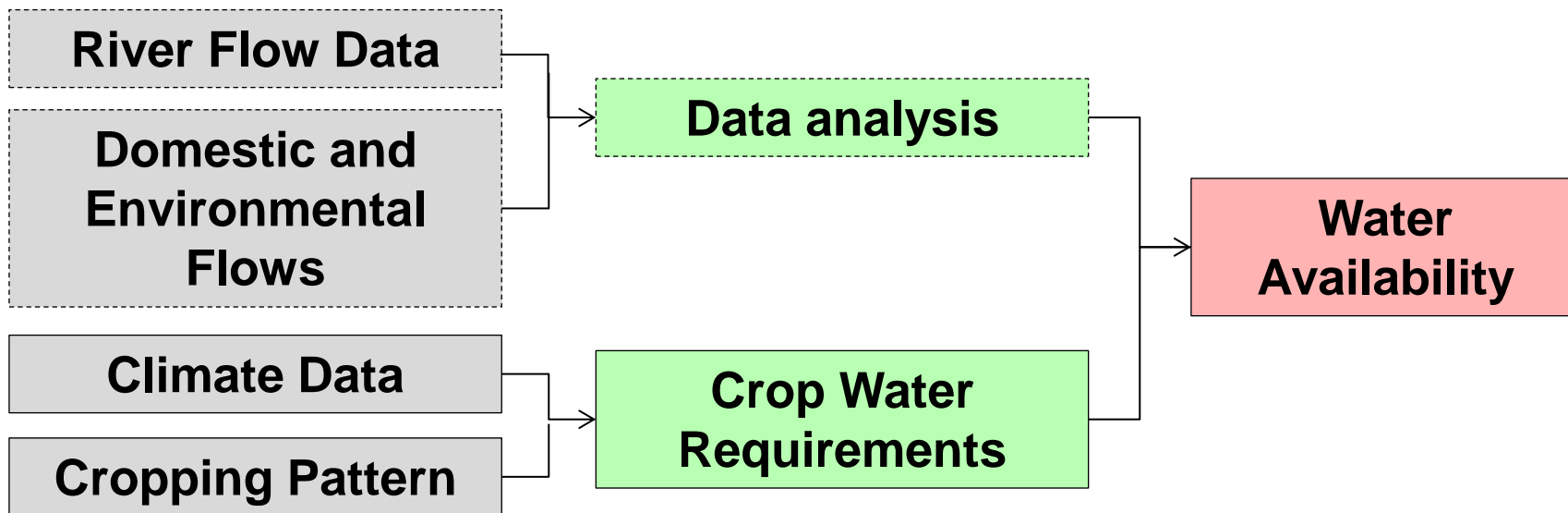

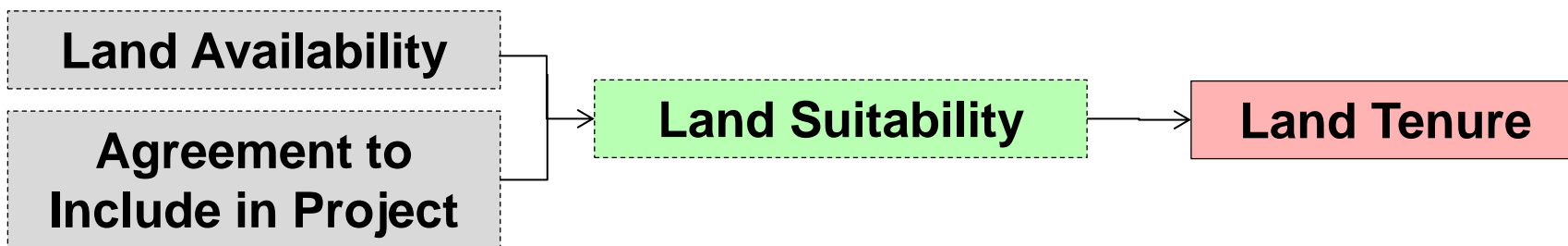

Hydrology Processes



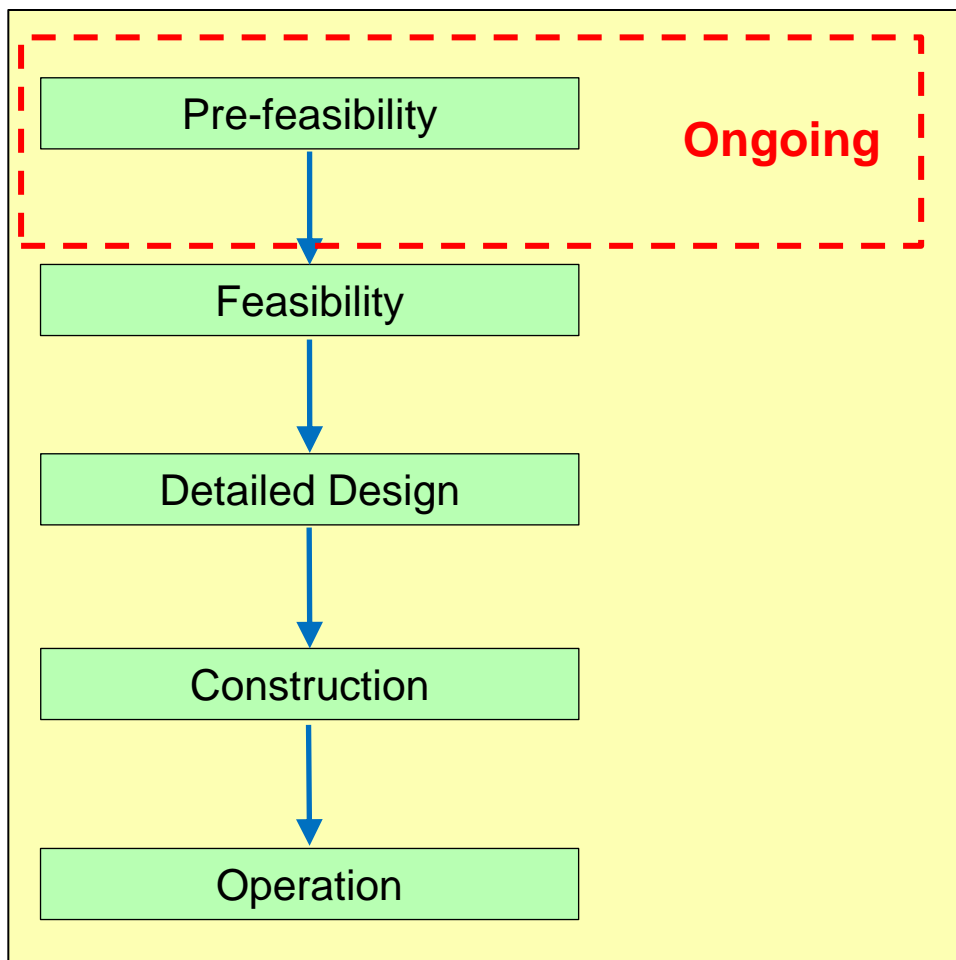
Land Tenure Processes



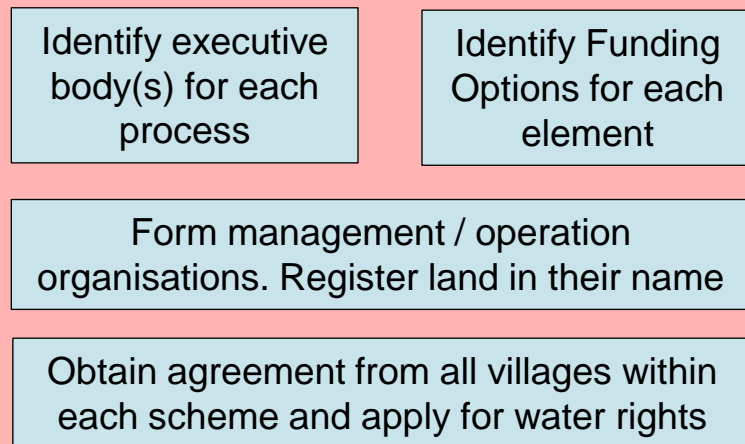


Implementation Processes / Timeline
